The inaugural Gala and auction could not have happened without the support received from a wide range of professionals such as the team at Blue Pie.



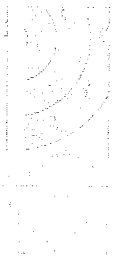

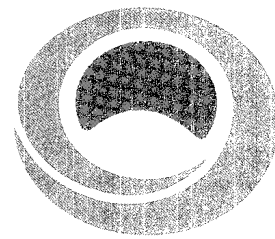
